Michigan Braille Transcribing Fund (MBTF) is the largest braille production facility in the nation. The facility transcribes textbooks and other printed materials into braille for the blind and visually impaired. MBTF also transcribes other materials such as contracts, legal documents, tests, exams, manuals, restaurant menus, election ballots, etc.
