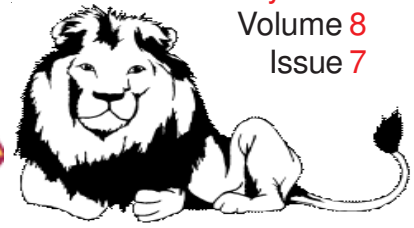

GLOBAL MEMBERSHIP TEAM

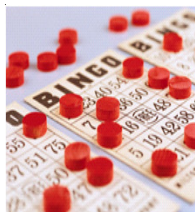

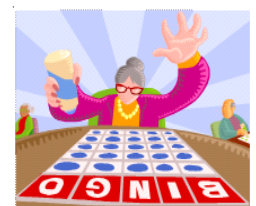

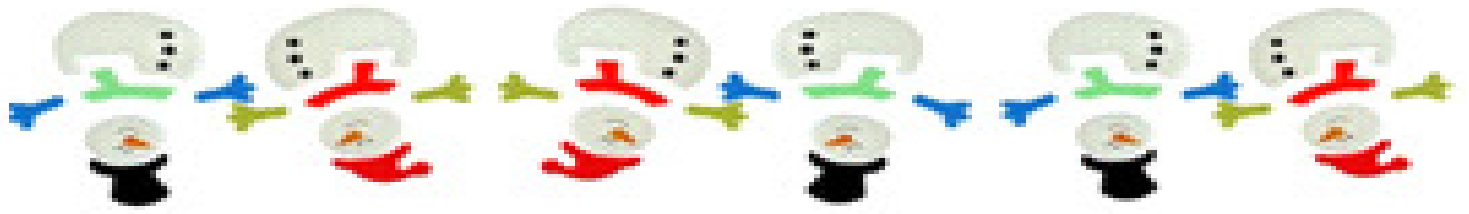
