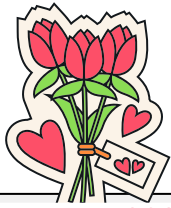

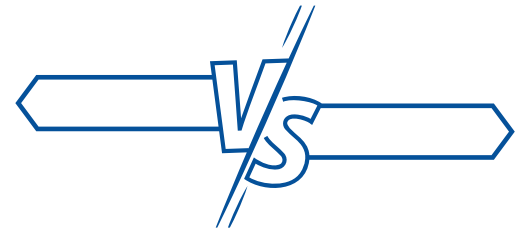

The Region that has the highest percentage (%) membership increase

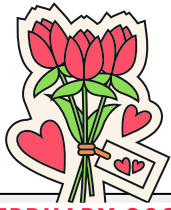

Mount Clemens Lions Charity Dinner

The Mount Clemens Lions welcomed representatives from local organizations, community groups and non-profits on Tuesday evening, January 24th, 2023, at the Rec Bowl in Mount Clemens to receive checks through funds raised during the 2022 Lions Soap Box Grand Prix. Also joining a dinner hosted and given by Rec Bowl owner Fred Fox were a number of volunteers who helped to make last year's 30th running of the race a huge success. A history of Soap Box Derby racing was provided by MC for the evening and Grand Prix Chairman Lion 2VP Darryl Hissong. Fred Fox gave a brief history of the Mount Clemens Grand Prix which began in 1992 with a few tavern owners hoping to generate some fun and excitement and bring people into the downtown area.

\$20,000 was distributed to thirteen different groups by Mount Clemens Lion Pres. Jim Ketchum. Recipients included: Maggie's Wigs 4 Kids, Mount Clemens Goodfellows, Boy Scout Troup 157, Mount Clemens Special Olympics, Turning Point, Mount Clemens Salvation Army, TCB Youth Mentoring, Family Youth Intervention, Mount Clemens Firefighters, Macomb Cable Network, Mount Clemens Discovery Center, Mount Clemens Barracudas Football Program and Fraser High School Athletics.

Guest speaker for the evening was Lion Peter Frame, whose Grandfather won the 1932 Indianapolis 500. The Mount Clemens Grand Prix, over its thirty years, has raised and given more than \$415,000.00 to local groups and charities.

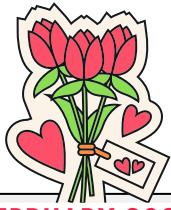

Royal Oak Lions at Forgotten Harvest

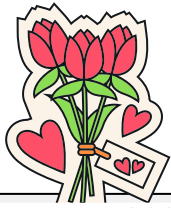
